MAIN LINE EXTENSION GUIDELINES PERTAINING TO PSC RULE 5.5

GUIDELINES FOR MAIN LINE EXTENSIONS

These guidelines are in addition to PSC regulations pursuant to Rule 5.5.

1. When District's contribution is applied, customer shall agree to pay at least the minimum monthly charge (per rate schedule) for a period of five (5) years, regardless if service is in use.
2. The District's contribution applies to initial construction only if there is a qualifying permanent and habitable structure in place at the time of extension construction, along with proof of a certified sewage disposal system.
3. Mobile home sites must have a health department approved septic system (proof must be provided), be on a permanent foundation, and axles and wheels must have been removed in order to qualify as a permanent structure for District's contribution.
4. Extensions over 500 feet shall be constructed by District's contractor of record.
5. Extensions under 500 feet, constructed according to PSC Rule 5.5, shall be constructed by the District's employees and contractor of record.
6. Travel campers do not qualify as a permanent structure. Therefore, the District's PSC Rule 5.5 obligation does not apply.
7. PSC Rule 5.5 reimbursement rule will apply within a ten year period of construction, upon proof of qualifying permanent and habitable structure and a certified sewage disposal system.
